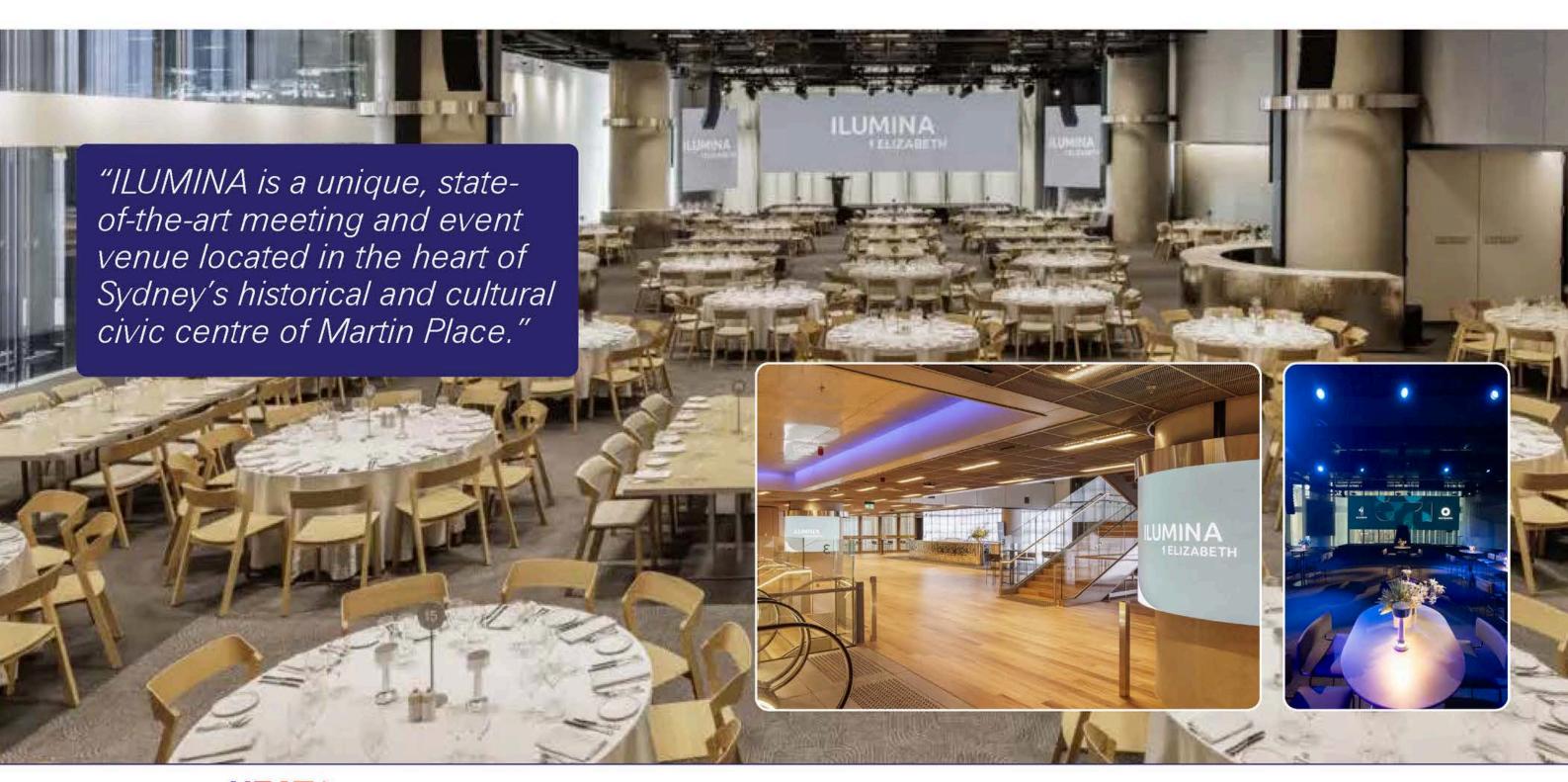




THE VENUE IN 2025
